Rick Marquette of Michigan, a former Reatta owner, has donated a 1991 Service Manual to the division and this will be given as a door prize to those attending the annual meeting. If you are thinking "shucks, I could use that manual but can't make it to Oklahoma." If you send in your vote for the division officers in this newsletter and renew your Reatta Division membership, your name will be placed in pot to be drawn for the manual. Minutes Reatta Division Meeting

Marriott Lone Tree, CO

Saturday, June 23, 2018; 3:00 pm

Meeting called to order by Director Anne Gibson



Announced current roster passed around, check beside name and make sure info is correct – make any corrections as needed.

Announced minutes of last meeting were in Summer newsletter. Anne Gibson made motion to accept the minutes, Isabel Lenny seconded the motion. Motion was accepted.

Treasurer's report was given out, motion to accept (Anne Gibson), seconded (Tom Lane). Motion accepted.

Elizabeth Lane – Newsletter report: please send in pictures and stories about your Reatta. Let me know what you want in the newsletter. There will be a Summer 2 newsletter – a 4 page edition for the national meet and 30th anniversary of the 1988 Reatta.

Anne Gibson discussed the Reatta Convertible Prototype: gave a short history of the car and its present home of San Diego Automotive Museum. SDAM needs more space and no longer has room for it. In trying to find a new home Anne has contacted numerous museums and only the National Automotive and Truck Museum in Auburn, IN has completed paperwork to accept this car.

Sid Meyer (head of the collections committee at the National Automotive and Truck Museum) gave an overview of the museum and stated that they are just waiting for approval by GM to accept the car.

Director Gibson stated that the Reatta Div. will again pay to ship the car from San Diego to Auburn once the approval by GM is finalized. Cost should be around \$2000. After a discussion about shipping, Frank Blizzard made a motion to put a limit of \$3000 on shipping the prototype. Seconded by Elizabeth Lane, motion carried.

Director Gibson mentioned that Reatta hats and visors were for sale at \$15 each and that she had brought the hats and visors to the meeting.

Director Gibson discussed members stepping up to take officer positions. In the past it has been difficult to fill positions and members have had to stay in positions, longer than they had planned. Elizabeth Lane asked

about 2 year staggered terms. Director Gibson would look into the by-laws and see if this would need to be a change to the by-laws.

Ballot count – out of 240 members – 15 ballots were returned. Officers for 2018-2019:

Anne Gibson – Director

Marck Barker – Asst. Director

Jerry Richstein – Secretary/Treasurer

Marck Barker presented the Peterson Award to Chuck Kerls for his service as past director and voice of the Reatta Division on the BCA Board. Chuck was not present, but Director Gibson stated that she would stop in Wichita, Kansas on the way home and present the award to Chuck.

Celebration for 1988 Reatta 30th Birthday with cake.

Barney Eaton presented some Reatta trivia – 30% of Reattas made are still registered. He also discussed the Convertible Prototype and how it was made.

Director Gibson discussed how she had gotten an email from a Reatta owner in England that was trying to get his Reatta registered and needed the date of manufacture. The car as imported into Holland in 1990 and according to the VIN was manufactured in Nov. of 1989.

Ed Lenny made an announcement about the hotel reservations to check your receipt to be sure you are under the Buick Block – otherwise you will be charged \$300 a night.

Larry May announced he had 2 interior burgundy panels for the 1988 Reatta for sale. Director Gibson suggested he put them in the next newsletter.

Marck Barker announced the 2021 National Meet would be in Charlotte, NC and that it would be the 30th anniversary of the 1991 Reattas and that the division would like for there to be 91 or more Reattas at this meet.

Director Gibson announced the 2019 National Meet in Midwest City, OK June 12-15, 2019 and that she hoped to see even more Reattas there.

Director Gibson adjourned the meeting at 3:41pm

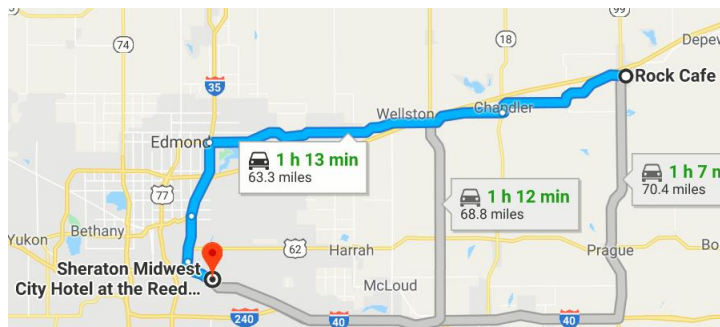
